Lukas, Selma and Grayharm are forcefully thrown into this horrific tale and will have to decipher the truth and find out the hard way that this kind of story never ends well.



Her dream of being an actress came to life when she starred in Tennessee Williams' Off Broadway and started interacting with the New-York elite of the 60s and 70s; she was among the first trans pioneer celebrities and eventually joined Andy Warhol's inner circle and Factory. Her closest friend, Jeremiah Newton, fondly and intimately recounts the many steps in journey, filled with trials and challenges, leading up to her tragic premature death at the age of 29.







Rwanda: Hunting down genocide fugitives recounts the investigation of Alain and Dafroza Gauthier who, for over 20 years, have been hunting down the Rwandan genocide fugitives hidden in France. In 1994, as she was living in Reims with her husband and three children, Dafroza's family and friends back in Rwanda were decimated. The couple quickly realized that many perpetrators had found refuge in France and decided to do whatever it took for justice to be served.

Alain and Dafroza go to Rwanda regularly to collect evidence and testimonies to open cases and judicial information leading to trials, at least in theory. As it turns out, many, many obstacles stand in their way, amongst them the sluggishness of the justice system, political back and forth, threats and exhaustion... This album and their story give precious insight on how the genocide happened, its origins and application but also on the French injustice: 200 to 400 genocide fugitives are estimated to live on French soil, yet the government refuses to extradite them to Rwanda – all the while taking years, sometimes decades, to bring them to justice.




