♦ Lison Ferné is an illustrator and comic book author. Her first comic book, La Déesse Requin, is published in 2020 and touches on many issues close to her heart: eco-responsibility, fantasy worlds and well-crafted female characters. Her latest, Mon Abécédaire Queer, comes out in 2023 and deals with the representation of the male body outside of the hegemonic manly pictured in many spaces. Her work in general is informed by feminism, pop-culture, and mythology.

Pierre Bourdieu has completely revolutionised the field of sociology and is known today as a major intellectual public figure. What if often overlooked though is his coming-ofage story: being as young as 25 in Algeria caught in the middle of a decolonization war.


