Pitch:

1915 – two children are caught in the middle of the Armenian Genocide.

April 1915. World War One is raging. A Turkish adolescent, Hassan, is entrusted with a perilous misson by his father: to escort two Armenian children, Maryam and Varto, to a safe place. On the occasion of the Armenian Genocide centenary commemoration, VARTO carries a message of reconciliation by shedding a light on a fact that was often forgotten in official historical accounts, either on the Armenian or the Turkish side: the rescue of Armenians from the massacres by « righteous » turks.
